“Notes on the 2300 Day Prophecy pt. 1.”

IMPORTANT PRINCIPLES IN STUDYING THIS PROPHECY:

Score = 20 years, Exodus 1:5, Deuteronomy 10:22. Day = Year in Bible Prophecy. Genesis 29:27, Ezekiel 4:6, Numbers 14:34.

1. Who came to Daniel to explain his dream of the Ram and the goat in Daniel 8? Daniel 8:16-19.
2. Which text in this prophecy was not explained in Daniel 8? Daniel 8:14.
3. What happened to Daniel while Gabriel was explaining the dream of the Rams and Goats in Daniel 8? Daniel 8:27.

NOTE: Daniel was overwhelmed, expecting the 70 years of captivity as stated in Jeremiah 29:10 (also on Isaiah 39:6-8, Jeremiah 25:11-12) to expire thinking that the 2300 days was an prolonging of their captivity and he fainted.

4. What prophecy did Daniel restudy some time after he has the vision of Rams and Goats? Daniel 9:1-2.
5. What did Daniel do in order to understand the vision? Daniel 9:3-20: Daniel 2:17-18, Proverbs 3:32. Psalms 25:14, Amos 3:7, Deuteronomy 29:29, Psalms 51:17, Job 22:21, James 1:5.
6. How do we know that the explanation of the vision of Daniel 8:1-14 is connected with the explanation of vision in Daniel 9:24-27?

NOTE: The Angel Gabriel visited both times to explain the vision. Daniel 8:16, Daniel 9:21.

In Daniel 9:23, Gabriel states, “At the beginning of thy supplications the commandment came forth, and I am come to shew *thee*; for thou *art* greatly beloved: therefore understand the matter, and consider the vision. .” Referring to Daniel 8:26, a reference to Daniel 8:14.

Also, Daniel 9:24, it states, that “Seventy weeks are determined upon they people...” The word determined in the original language means cut off. The question is, seventy weeks are cut off from what? The verse that is mathematical that can cut off from Daniel 9:24 is in Daniel 8:14, the 2300 days. Thus, Daniel 9:24 to Daniel 8:14 is connected as the same vision.

Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to **finish the transgression**, and to **make an end of sins**, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Daniel 9:24. (The Jews were given 490 years of probation to make things right with God).

7. When did the seventy weeks begin? 457 B.C. (Ezra 6:14, Ezra 7:11-26).
8. What happened after the seven weeks?
 - Seven weeks or forty nine years after Artaxerxes decree, Jerusalem’s reconstruction was completed. From the end of the Seven weeks begins the 62 weeks or 434 years.

9. What occurred after the 434 years, otherwise known as the 69 weeks? Daniel 9:25.

- Messiah also means anointed, Daniel 9:25 where it states “to anoint the most Holy” is also a reference to the Messiah/Jesus. Christ was anointed through baptism on 27 AD (Acts 10:37-38, Matthew 3:16-17, Luke 3:21-23, Mark 1:14-15, John 1:29-34).
- The Messiah = Christ. John 1:40-42. Two texts that show that Christ’s ministry and sacrifice is tied to the prophetic timeline. Mark 1:15, Galatians 4:4.

NOTE: We can determine that Jesus was baptized exactly at AD 27 based on Luke 3:1. Where it states that Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist in the fifteenth year of the reign of Tiberus Ceaser.

10. What significant event is predicted **after** the 69 weeks? Daniel 9:26-27. The Messiah will be cut off. **Cut off** which in the original means destroyed.

NOTE: “The people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined,” on this text refers to the destruction of Jerusalem by the Roman Empire. Jesus alluded to it in Luke 13:34-35, Luke 19:41-44.

And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make *it* desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate (**Daniel 9:27**).

11. What covenant was confirmed? Genesis 3:15, Matthew 26-26-28, John 1:29, Hebrews 2:3, Galatians 3:17.

12. What occurred in the midst of the week? Luke 23:33.

Christ was crucified on 14 Nisan AD 31. Christ was crucified on the date of the Passover (John 19:14). John 19:31 (High Sabbath matches the Passover).

13. What stopped after Christ’s death at the cross? Daniel 9:27, Matthew 27:46-51, Mark 15:38, and Luke 23:45. Christ’s sacrifice ended the ceremonial sacrifices and offerings and was the anti-type Passover lamb: John 1:29, 1 Corinthians 5:7. Colossians 2:13-14,

14. What did Christ do when Stephen was stoned and what significance does this have? Acts 7:56, Isaiah 3:13, Daniel 12:1.

15. What did Christ commanded His disciples to do before the seventy week prophecy expired? Matthew 10:5-8.

16. What did the followers of Christ do after Stephen was stoned? Acts 8:1, Acts 13:46-47.

17. How merciful was God to the Israel? Daniel 9:24, Exodus 34:6-7, Matthew 18:22 (Christ stated that forgiveness of seventy times seven reflects the 70 week prophecy).

18. How did God appeal to Israel throughout the ages? 2 Chronicles 36:14-15, Jeremiah 3:22-25, Jeremiah 9:1, 12-14, Jeremiah 14:17, Jeremiah 30:11, Ezekiel 36:19-33, Hosea 4:1-6, Luke 19:41-44.

19. What happens to those who are not ethnically Jews who accept Christ as their Savior and God? Romans 2:28-29, Galatians 3:14, 28-29.
