“2300 Days Pt. 2: The Day of Atonement/Investigative Judgment.”

- (1) What would happen after the 2300 prophetic days? Daniel 8:14.
- (2) What was the event called of the literal cleansing of the Heavenly Sanctuary? Hebrews 9:7, Leviticus 16: 16-19, 29-34.

NOTE: *The Day of Atonement* is still kept by many Jews today. It's the most solemn day of the year in the Jewish calendar. The 2300 day/year prophecy began on 457 B.C. with the command to rebuild Jerusalem, to the year 1844 A.D. On 22 October was the Day of Atonement, thus the actual cleansing of the Heavenly Sanctuary begin in October 22, 1844.

- (3) What is Jesus Christ's role in the Day of Atonement? Hebrews 4:14-16, Hebrews 8:1-6.
- (4) What function does Jesus serve for us to God the Father? 1 Timothy 2:5, 1 John 1:9, 1 John 2:1.
- (5) Did the Apostle Paul look forward to the prophetic Day of Atonement? Hebrews 9:24-28.
- (6) What does the Apostle Peter say that will happen to us if we truly forsake and be sorry for our sins? Acts 3:19-21.
- (7) When did this judgment occur? Revelation 14:6-7.
- (8) What happens during the Antitypical Day of Atonement? Daniel 7: 9-10.
- (9) Did the judgment happen in Paul's day? Acts 24:25.
10. From what standard are we judged by? Psalms 96:13, Ecclesiastes 12:13-14, Romans 2:12-13.
11. How is God judging us? Ecclesiastes 3:17, Revelation 20:13.
12. Where does judgment begin? 1 Peter 4:17, Revelation 20:12.
13. What happens at the end of the Day of Atonement/Investigative judgment? Leviticus 16:20/ Revelation 22:11. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17.
14. What is promised to the righteous in the judgment? Revelation 3:5.
15. Whom does the High Priest transfer all the sins that were ever recorded throughout history? Leviticus 16:20-22/ Revelation 20:1-3.
16. What happens to the devil during this time? Revelation 20:4-5.
17. What is the purpose of this whole investigative judgment? 2 Corinthians 5:17-21.
18. What promise does God give that allows those that are faithful should not fear the investigative judgment? 1 John 4:16-18.
