“Law, Grace, and the Commandments, Pt. 1”

1. What does the Bible says as the Love of God? 1 John 5:2-4, John 14:15.
2. What is the test to determine if people really know God and have the light of God in them? 1 John 2:3-4, Isaiah 8:20.
3. What are the commandments referring to? Matthew 22:37-40. Deut 6:5, Leviticus 19:18, Exodus 20:1-17. (NOTE: The first four commandments show us how we should love God, and the last six shows us how we should love our neighbor as ourselves).
4. Were the Commandments being kept before they were given to Moses? Genesis 26:5.
5. What other beings keep God’s commandments? Psalms 103:19-20.
6. What does God promise to do to the hearts of those who want to obey His word? Ezekiel 36:25-28.
7. What else does God promise to those who desire to obey His commandments? Hebrews 8:10-13, Jeremiah 31:33, Proverbs 7:1-3.
8. What are characteristics of God’s people in the last days? Revelation 12:17, Revelation 14:12.

What event needs to occur so Christ can come? Matthew 24:14. (NOTE: The word “witness” in the original Greek has a special meaning in this text.

Mat 24:14 And²⁵³² this⁵¹²⁴ gospel²⁰⁹⁸ of the³⁵⁸⁸ kingdom⁹³² shall be preached²⁷⁸⁴ in¹⁷²² all³⁶⁵⁰ the³⁵⁸⁸ world³⁶²⁵ for¹⁵¹⁹ a witness³¹⁴² unto all³⁹⁵⁶ nations,¹⁴⁸⁴ and²⁵³² then⁵¹¹⁹ shall the³⁵⁸⁸ end⁵⁰⁵⁶ come.²²⁴⁰

1. What are five laws that we can find in scripture?
 - A. Civil Laws: Matthew 22:21, Romans 12:18, 1 Peter 2:13-18 (NOTE: We are to do our part to obey the laws of the government as long as it does not go in conflict with the Word of God. Galatians 1:10-12, Matthew 22:37-40).
 - B. Health Laws: 1 Corinthians 10:31, Deuteronomy 7:11-14.
 - C. Natural Law. Jeremiah 5:22.
 - D. Ceremonial law. Stated throughout the book of Leviticus.
 - E. God’s Moral Law. Exodus 20:1-17.

2. What is the purpose of the moral law? 1 John 3:4, Romans 4:15, James 2:9-13, Galatians 3:23-24.

3. What does Paul write about the law and the commandments? Romans 7:12.

4. What law was nailed to the cross? Colossians 2:14-16.
 - A. What is the **handwriting of ordinances** and who wrote them? 2 Chronicles 33:8, Deut 31:9.
 - B. What was “**contrary against us**?” Deut 31:26.
 - C. What were some of the ordinances? 2 Chronicles 35:6, 10-12.
 - D. What was significant of this book of the law? Deut 31:26.
 - E. How were the Ten Commandments written? Exodus 31:18, Deut 9:10.
 - F. Where is the (moral law) Ten Commandments located? Exodus 31:7, Revelation 11:19. **(NOTE: the earthly sanctuary was a pattern of an actual Heavenly Sanctuary where Christ serves as our High Priest. Exodus 25:8-9, Hebrews 8:1-6).**
 - G. What were the **meat and drink** referring to (Colossians 2:16)? Leviticus 23:13, 37-38, Numbers 29:15-16, 21, and Ezekiel 45:17.
 - H. What are the “new moons” referring to? Ezra 3:4-5.
 - I. Which Sabbath days is this referring to? Leviticus 23:24, Leviticus 23:37-38.
 - J. What distinction are these Sabbaths from the Sabbath of the moral law? Leviticus 23:38 (NOTE: notice the word “between”), Exodus 20:8-10. Notice the word “THE.”

5. How did Christ fulfill the Shadow of the ordinances? John 1:29, Matthew 27:51, John 19:31, 1 Corinthians 5:7.

6. What was accomplished with Christ’s sacrifice? Romans 5:16-18 :

7. What was the gift that we receive when we accept Christ’s sacrifice? Romans 6:6, 14.

8. Since we are under grace, does that give us the right now to sin? Romans 6:16-18.

9. What is a specific thing grace does for us? Titus 2:11-14.

10. What is Righteousness? Psalms 119:172.

11. What will the saints possess in the last days? Revelation 14:12.

God will give us the power to obey His commandments by faith in His power. May God give us a good name and may our name remain.
