“Blessed.” H1288

בָּרַךְ *bârak baw-rak'*: A primitive root; to *kneel*; by implication to *bless* God (as an act of adoration), and (vice-versa) man (as a benefit); also (by euphemism) to *curse* (God or the king, as treason): - X abundantly, X altogether, X at all, blaspheme, bless, congratulate, curse, X greatly, X indeed, kneel (down), praise, salute, X still, thank

“Sanctified.” H6942

קָדַשׁ *qâdash kaw-dash'*: A primitive root; to *be* (causatively *make, pronounce* or *observe* as) *clean* (ceremonially or morally): - appoint, bid, consecrate, dedicate, defile, hallow, (be, keep) holy (-er, place), keep, prepare, proclaim, purify, sanctify (-ied one, self), X wholly.

“Rested.” H7673

שָׁבַת *shâbath shaw-bath'*: A primitive root; to *repose*, that is, *desist* from exertion; used in many implied relations (causatively, figuratively or specifically): - (cause to, let, make to) cease, celebrate, cause (make) to fail, keep (sabbath), suffer to be lacking, leave, put away (down), (make to) rest, rid, still, take away.

“Hallowed.” H6942

קָדַשׁ *qâdash kaw-dash'*

A primitive root; to *be* (causatively *make, pronounce* or *observe* as) *clean* (ceremonially or morally): - appoint, bid, consecrate, dedicate, defile, hallow, (be, keep) holy (-er, place), keep, prepare, proclaim, purify, sanctify (-ied one, self), X wholly.

“Custom.” **G1485** ἔθος *ethos eth'-os* From G1486; a *usage* (prescribed by habit or law): - custom, manner, be wont.

12. Did the followers of Jesus keep the Sabbath? Luke 23:54-56, Luke 24:1.

13. Did the Apostles keep the Sabbath? Acts 13:13-15.

14. Did the gentiles in the New Testament worship on the Sabbath? Acts 13:42-44, Acts 16:13, Acts 17:2-4, Acts 18:4.

15. Will we keep the Sabbath in Heaven? Isaiah 66:22-23.
